

21. Councillor Training

Councillor Training is advised for new councillors. CALC offer the training individually, where delegates join a group session. They will also offer dedicated bespoke training, where they will deliver the training session to all members of a council, adapted to suit their needs.

It may be just as cost effective to arrange a training session for the whole Council, which everybody attends, including re-elected councillors, who can use this as a refresher course. If there are particular topics or areas that we want to discuss in greater detail we will have the freedom to direct the course.

The Council must decide if they wish to attend training individually or as a group.

If councillors wish to attend individually the clerk will forward details of the training sessions available.

If councillors wish to attend as a group, the clerk will get a list of available dates from CALC and circulate to councillors so that one can be agreed.
